## Course Objectives

The 1<sup>st</sup> Trimester Ultrasound Training course is designed for learners with a beginning-intermediate level understanding of ultrasound principles and practical experience with scanning. The emphasis of this course is to provide the skills and knowledge required to successfully use ultrasound during the first trimester of pregnancy to:

- Evaluate for normal and abnormal conditions in pregnancy
