- **Other:** Half of the resident class will spend their first 6 months on non-psychiatric rotations while the other half spends 6 months on psychiatric rotations. After 6 months each cohort of residents will switch between psychiatry and medicine/neurology. Residents rotating on psychiatry will spend 0.5 days per week in didactics.

- **Scholarly Activity/Research Track:** Residents will have time during their first few months of PGY3 to work on scholarly activity while they build their outpatient panel. Residents who fulfill the eligibility requirement for the research track will receive approval from the program director to receive 0.5 days a week protected time during PGY3.
- **Other:** On a weekly basis, residents will spend 4.5 days on ROC and 0.5 days in didactics. Residents who are in the research track will have an alternative schedule of 4 days on ROC, 0.5 days on child and adolescent psychiatry (at site 1) and 0.5 days in didactics. Residents who pursue elective rotations will have an alternative schedule of 4 days on ROC, 0.5 days on elective, and 0.5 days in didactics.

The remaining 2 days per week will be spent in the following ways: 1-2 residents will be selected by peers, faculty and program directors to be the Chief Resident (s) for Medical Education for 12 months; all other residents are required to be a Chief Resident of a clinical service for 6 months and will spend the other 6 months on electives.
