Distinct 13-month Fellowships in Community Health

- 1 Community Medicine & Global Health Fellowship at **Napa-Solano**
- 2 Community Medicine & Health Disparities Fellowship at **Oakland**
- 3 Community Medicine & Public Health Fellowship at **Sacramento Valley**
- 4 Community Medicine & Urban Health Fellowship at **San Francisco**
- 5 Community Medicine & Vulnerable Populations Fellowship at **San Jose**
- 6 Community Medicine & Leadership Fellowship at **Santa Clara**
- 7 Community Medicine & Integrative Medicine Fellowship at **Santa Rosa**

During the 13-month fellowships time will be spent as follows:

- 50-70%** **Community-based Primary Care**
Fellows will provide Primary Care to the medically underserved community-based clinics and Federally Qualified Health Centers
- 10-30%** **Community Project and Didactics**
Fellows will have protected time for didactics and dedicated mentors to help develop their required community-based scholarly project
- 10-20%** **Kaiser Permanente Clinics**
Fellows will spend 1-2 half-days per week learning the Kaiser system first-hand by performing clinical duties at a Kaiser Permanente site
- 10-20%** **Other Opportunities**
Fellows will also have options to pursue rotations in Global Health, Health Policy, conduct mentored research, and further develop community-based initiatives
