Undergraduate

- 4 years
(Minimum Admission Requirements*)
High School Diploma (or Certificate of General Education Development (GED))
- Completed High School with grades of C or better
 - Minimum academic preparatory courses:
 - History/Social Science
 - English
 - Mathematics
 - Laboratory Science
 - Language (other than English)
 - Visual and Performing Arts
 - College Preparatory Electives
 - Taken the Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) or American College Testing (ACT)



Independent Practice

- Medical Degree (MD, DO, DPM)
- Passed the United States Medical Licensing Examinations (USMLE)
 - Completion of specialty (residency) training
 - State Medical License

Fellowship

- (optional)
1 year minimum†
- Medical Degree (MD, DO, DPM)
 - Passed the United States Medical Licensing Examinations (USMLE)
 - Completion of residency training (specialty of choice)

Medical School

- 4 years
(Minimum Admission Requirements*)
Bachelor of Science (BS) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) Degree
- Completion of the following undergraduate courses:
 - One year of Biology
 - One year of Physics
 - One year of English
 - Two years of Chemistry
 - Passed the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT)

Residency

- 3 years minimum†
(Minimum Admission Requirements**)
- Medical Degree (MD, DO, DPM)
 - Passed the United States Medical Licensing Examinations (USMLE)
