Research and Scholarly Activity Program Aims:

- Understand the importance scholarly activity in medical practice.
- Become competent consumers of medical literature.
- Demonstrate the ability to use clinically-relevant research to promote health and wellness in patients.
- Demonstrate working knowledge of scholarly activity processes through didactic learning and production of scholarly work.
- Disseminate scholarly work to the local, regional and/or national community.
- Cultivate a life-long learner approach to clinical practice.

Program Requirements

General Residency Requirements:

Each resident will complete the required elements. We encourage creativity in completion of scholarly activity requirements. Please submit any unlisted scholarly activities, in writing, to the Residency Scholarly Activity Advisory Committee (e.g., Research Project Manager, Resident Research Director). They will be reviewed on an ongoing basis.

Required Elements:

- Completion of a well-designed scholarly project with dissemination activity*
- Completion of a well-designed QI Project with dissemination activity*
- Co-lead/Lead 2 Journal Clubs (PGY-1, -2)
- Participate in a Morbidity and Mortality Conference in Psychiatry (PGY-3)
- Completion of one Continuing Medical Education or Grand Rounds (PGY-3 or 4)
 - project with a dissemination activity.

List of possible Dissemination Activities:

- Submit a manuscript

* For residents who fast-track, they are required to complete only one scholarly project or QI


Present a poster, visual abstract, or abstract at a local, regional or national conference Give a presentation at a local, regional, or national conference, continuing medical education


