- Vacation: Residents have 4 weeks of vacation.
- Research Track: Residents who have an interest in research must notify the Program Director prior to the end of PGY1 in order to be eligible for protected time in the last 12 weeks of their PGY2 schedule.
- Other: Half of the resident class spends their first 6 months on non-psychiatric rotations while the other half spends 6 months on psychiatric rotations. After 6 months each cohort of residents. Residents rotating on psychiatry spend one half-day per week in didactics. Weekend C-L call occurs between PGY1-3, beginning with a limited buddy-call experience where PGY1's are paired with a PGY2. Internal Medicine currently has a rotating long-call system, but no overnight call.
