

Dr. Brian W. Lin Memorial Scholarship for Medical Students



The Brian W. Lin Memorial Scholarship is created to honor Dr. Brian W. Lin, a Kaiser Permanente Emergency Medicine Physician, Director of Undergraduate Medical Education, and creator of the Kaiser Longitudinal Integrated Clerkship (KLIC) at KP San Francisco.

This scholarship seeks to support medical students who have participated in or are currently involved in a longitudinal clinical experience and have demonstrated a commitment to teaching, mentorship, and educational innovation.

Scholarship Criteria

- Be a current **third or fourth-year** medical student in good academic standing who expects to graduate in the spring of 2027 or 2028
- Enrolled in an accredited allopathic, osteopathic or podiatric medical school
- Scholarship Amount: **\$5,000**
- Submit completed application by October 23, 2026
